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DID YOU KNOW?

FLSA CHANGES: RESTORING & EXTENDING OVERTIME PROTECTIONS

Effective July 1st, 2024 the Department of Labor approved a final rule that adjusted the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA).

Notable changes include:

- Increased standard salary level
- <u>Increased total annual</u> <u>compensation requirements</u>
- <u>The addition of a mechanism to</u> <u>update the salary thresholds</u> <u>every three years</u>
